An aquarium with robust and reliable plants that is easy to tend and maintain.

By means of the fast-growing Vallisneria, Hygrophila, Ludwigia and Echinodorus, the aquarium quickly gains a mass of plants that makes it stable. The low-light plants Anubias and Monosolenium are placed under Vallisneria and Echinodorus, while a ground cover of Lilaeopsis brasiliensis and Hydrocotyle tripartita gain light in front. Red Alternanthera 'Rosanervig' and Ludwigia sp. are used as focus plants.

Maintenance (hours per week):	½-1
