Soft, bright green hillsides lead to a centerpiece of *Hygrophila pinnatifida* and *Bolbitis* overhanging this scenario. It requires careful trimming to achieve and maintain.

Notice the use of *Anubias petite*. *Anubias* appreciates the much lower levels of light under the piece of wood.

## Technique

Aquarium:	DENNERLESCAPER'S TANK
Volume:	55 L
Light:	Dennerle Tropical LED 40 cm (18 watt 1.680 lumen)
Substrate:	Tropica Aquarium Soil
Gravel:	Tropica Aquarium Soil
Decoration:	Driftwood
Filter:	Dennerle Scaper's Flow (360L/h)
CO2:	15 mg/L
Fertiliser (weekly):	25 ml Premium Nutrition + 25 ml Specialised
Maintenance (hours per week):	½-1
