The layout is a play with the interior and the theme in correlation with limited light conditions and no CO2 supply. A relaxed layout with room for fun. Anubias and Microsorium are robust and shadow-tolerant. Ludwigia, Pogostemon and Nymphoides can grow without CO2 and offer different leaf forms and light colours. The moss grows slowly without CO2 and with little light, and are used here as short plants (bound to stones) and as funny balls freely floating in the water. The layout is maintenance-friendly and decorative.

Tips! Moss can be used in many ways - as here, for example, where the moss is tied to a plastic grated ball and fixed to the substrate with a fishing line and an anchor buried in the gravel.

Technique

Aquarium:	EHEIM
Volume:	54 L
Light:	T8 - 15W
Gravel:	Gravel 0.8-1.2 mm, blue + black
Fertiliser (weekly):	10 ml Premium Fertiliser+ 30 ml Specialised
Maintenance (hours per week):	$\frac{1}{2}$
