The classical valley, surrounded by plants with texture, form and colour. On the edge of the vigorous plain of Riccia stand Hydrocotyle Tripartita and Pogostemon Helfereri and add to the fresh green. The play of colours in red-violet Ludwigia Glandulosa and Hygrophila Araguaia is beautifully highlighted by the intense, light green base colour. Rocks and aquarium glass are softened by Eleocharis, reflected effectively.

**Tip!** Riccia is fixed to small pieces of rock that need pruning and fixing on a regularly basis, in order to maintain the unique look.

Aquarium:	MARINA
Volume:	35 L
Light:	2 x 11W
Substrate:	Tropica Substrate
Gravel:	Black 2-3mm gravel
Filter:	External
CO2:	2 bubbles per second
Maintenance (hours per week):	1-2
