The children's aquarium should be fun and easy. All children know Nemo, surrounded by sea anemones and jellyfish.

Nemo hides in two *Anubias nana* that are carefully attached on both sides of the figure. *Cabomba caroliniana* and *Egeria densa* are the easiest stem plants for the aquarium. Split the bundle into separate stems and plant them on the bottom layer. The stem grows steadily and is cut off 5-10cm over the bottom, when touching the surface. The cut off stem can be planted on the bottom layer to repeat the process.

Technique

Aquarium:	SUPERFISH
Volume:	20 L
Light:	1 x low energy bulb 9W (approx. 800 lux)
Substrate:	Tropica substrate
Gravel:	Pluto 3-5 mm Akvastabil
Filter:	Aqua Flow 50
CO2:	Tropica System 60
Fertiliser (weekly):	Specialised Fertiliser 10 ml
Maintenance (hours per week):	$\frac{1}{2}$
