A small and well-functioning aquarium!

This aquarium does not have an awful lot of light, but the quadratic layout ensures uniform light distribution.

A diagonal mangrove root creates coherence, depth and fine growing conditions for Anubias 'Petite'.

The fertile bottom layer of *Lilaeopsis brasiliensis* does not require much light and only limited care. The stem plants *Hottonia* and *Rotala* grow faster and require regular cutting.

Technique

Aquarium:	SUPERFISHWAVE 15
Volume:	15 L
Light:	LED 2100 lux
Gravel:	Flora Base black, small pellet
Filter:	Superfish Aquaflow 50
CO2:	Tropica System 60
Fertiliser (weekly):	Specialised Fertiliser 20 ml
Maintenance (hours per week):	$\frac{1}{2}$
